Madam/Sir,

In reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to say that it has come to notice ~~at~~ the Government that many students have not joined in their slide up colleges, even if that were considered for taking admission during 2nd and 3rd round of selection in +2 (Junior) admission during this year 2017-18.

Therefore, it is suggested that one more chance will be given to such type of students to go to slide up colleges and they can be adjusted against the vacancies, if any. If no vacancies exit or any extra seat is required, that can be created over and above the sanctioned seats for this year only. They are bound to go to slide up colleges by 17th July, 2017.

The CLC, which has come out along with the intimation letter will be valid for this purpose and colleges are requested to accept this. This same process also applicable for +3(Degree) admissions only.
